GoFirst airlines, which had rebranded itself two years ago, filed for bankruptcy with the National Company Law Tribunal last week. ### Santiniketan may be added to World Heritage List

### The Hindu Bureau NEW DELHI

Santiniketan, associated with Nobel laureate Rabindranath Tagore, has been recommended for inclusion on UNESCO's World Heritage List.

The quaint town in West Bengal's Birbhum district is also home to the Visva-Bharati University built by Tagore. The recommendation was made by the International Council on Monuments and Sites (ICOMOS), which is the advisory body to the UNESCO World Heritage Centre, based on a file moved by the Centre. The nomination would be formally announced at the World Heritage Committee meeting to be held at Riyadh, Saudi Arabia in September 2023, Union Minister for Culture G. Kishen Reddy said.

Santiniketan, if selected, would be the second cultural symbol from West Bengal, to make it to the UNESCO list. In 2021, UN-ESCO had included '*Durga Puja* in Kolkata' on its list of Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity.

 It was established by <u>Maharshi Devendranath Tagore</u>, and later expanded by his son, <u>Rabindranath Tagore</u> whose vision became what is now a university town with the creation of <u>Visva-Bharati</u>



In 1863, <u>Debendranath Tagore</u> took on permanent lease 20 acres (81,000 m<sup>2</sup>) of land, with two *chhatim* (<u>Alstonia scholaris</u>) trees, at an annual payment of Rs. 5, from Bhuban Mohan Sinha, the <u>talukdar</u> of Raipur, Birbhum.



He built a guest house there and named it *Shantiniketan* (the abode of peace). Gradually, the whole area came to be known as Shantiniketan







 <u>Ballabhpur Wildlife Sanctuary</u> is located 3 km from Shantiniketan and is popular as Deer Park. Established in 1977, it was a <u>khoai</u> area affected by soil erosion. It is now a large wooded area with herds of deer and makes a natural bird sanctuary.

The Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) on Wednesday successfully conducted a trial run of delivery of blood bags under its iDrone initiative.

The trial run has been undertaken for the first time in the country by the ICMR; Lady Hardinge Medical College (LHMC); Government Institute of Medical Sciences (GIMS), Greater Noida; and the Jaypee Institute of Information Technology (JIIT), Noida, a release issued by the Health Ministry said.

The inaugural trial flight carried 10 units of whole blood samples from the GIMS and the LHMC in visual line of sight.

"The i-DRONE was first used during the COVID-19 pandemic by the ICMR for

distributing vaccines to remote areas. Today, we are transporting blood and blood-related products which are supposed to be kept at a low temperature. # **RBI's Gold Reserves**

As per <u>RBI's Half Yearly Report on</u> Management of Foreign Exchange Reserves: October 2022 - March 2023, its gold reserves touched 794.64 metric tonnes in FY 22-23, an increase of nearly 5% over FY 21-22(760.42 metric tonnes)

> Gold reserves along with foreign currency assets, <u>special drawing rights</u> and reserve tranche position in the <u>International</u> <u>Monetary Fund</u> make up <u>India's forex</u> <u>reserves.</u>



As per RBI, **437.22 tonnes of gold are held overseas** are held with the Bank of England and the **Bank of International Settlements (BIS)**, and **301.10 tonnes of gold is held domestically.** 



As on March 31, 2023, the **country's total forex reserves stood at \$578.449 billion**, and **gold reserves were pegged at \$45.2 billion**.

In value terms (USD), the share of gold in the total forex Eserves increased to about 7.81% at the end of March 2023.

  - According to the World Gold Council's regional CEO (India), the RBI is among the top five central banks that are buying gold.

### Which Other Banks are Buying Gold?

- According to the <u>World Gold Council (WGC)</u>, gold is being bought mainly by central banks of emerging market economies.
  - The WGC report said that in 2022, the People's Bank of China reported the first increase in its gold reserves since September 2019.
    China has been historically a large buyer of gold.

- During 2022, the central banks from the Middle East, including Egypt, Qatar, Iraq, the UAE, and Oman significantly boosted their gold reserves.
  - By the end of 2022, the Central Bank of Uzbekistan became a net purchaser of gold, with its gold reserves rising by 34 tonnes.

 In January-March 2023, the Monetary Authority of Singapore was the largest single buyer of gold after it added 69 tonnes to its gold reserves

# Sittwe Port

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 Recently, India and Myanmar jointly inaugurated the Sittwe Port in Myanmar's Rakhine State, marking an important milestone in enhancing bilateral and regional trade while also contributing to the local economy of the state.



The port's operationalization is expected to provide **greater connectivity and leads to employment opportunities**, as well as enhance growth prospects in the region.

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The project aims to provide an alternative connectivity route for **Mizoram with Indian ports through the Kaladan River in Myanmar.**   It includes segments such as shipping from Haldia to Sittwe port, inland water transport from Sittwe to Paletwa via the Kaladan River, road transport from Paletwa to the Indo-Myanmar border, and further road transport to NH.54 in India.  The Sittwe Port is part of the Kaladan Multi-Modal Transit Transport Project, funded by the Indian government, and will play a crucial role in linking India's East Coast to the Northeastern states through waterways and roads.
