Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Monday announced the successful test-firing of Agni-5 ballistic missile with Multiple Independently Targetable Reentry Vehicle (MIRV) technology by the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) under Mission Divyastra.

The flight test was carried out from Dr A.P.J. Abdul Kalam Island in Odisha. This is considered a major technological breakthrough.

Report shows dip in India's liberal democracy

India, which was downgraded to the status of an "electoral autocracy" in 2018, has declined even further on a liberal democratic index to emerge as "one of the worst autocratisers", according to a report by Gothenburg-based V-Dem Institute. **» PAGE 4**

Liberal democracy has declined significantly in India: report

The Hindu Bureau NEW DELHI

India, which was downgraded to the status of an "electoral autocracy" in 2018, has declined even further on multiple metrics to emerge as "one of the worst autocratisers", according to the "Democracy Report 2024" released by the Gothenburg-based V-Dem Institute.

The report categorises countries into four regime types based on their score in the Liberal Democratic Index (LDI): Liberal Democracy, Electoral Democracy, Electoral Autocracy, and Closed Autocracy. "India, with 18% of the world's population, accounts for about half of the population living in autocratising countries," the report said.

Noting that almost all components of democracy were getting worse in more countries than they were getting better, the report singled out freedom of expression, clean elections,

and freedom of association/civil society as the three worst affected components of democracy in autocratising countries. South and Central Asia regressed significantly, with the level of "liberal

with the level of "liberal democracy" enjoyed by the average Indian now "down to levels last seen in 1975...when Indira Gandhi declared a state of emergency in India". As per the V-Dem classification, a liberal democracy is one where, in addition to the requirements of electoral democracy such as regular free and fair elections, mechanisms for judicial independence and constraints on executive overreach are robust, alongside rigorous protection of civil liberties and equality before law.

"The Modi-led government also continues to suppress the freedom of religion rights. Intimidation of political opponents and people protesting government policies, and silencing of dissent in academia are now prevalent," the report noted.

With regard to India, the report said that a third con-

secutive term for the BJP and Mr. Modi "could lead to further autocratisation given the already substantial democratic decline under Modi's leadership and the enduring crackdown on minority rights and civil society".

V-Dem's Democracy Report is a collaborative project involving 4,200 scholars from 180 countries, and is based on 31 million datasets that cover 202 countries from 1789 to 2023.

India Ranked 104, Between Niger and Ivory Coast, on the Liberal Democracy Index: Report

The V-Dem report terms India as "one of the worst autocratisers lately", and in the "top ten autocratisers" in the world. It dropped to an 'electoral autocracy' in 2018 and has stayed there in 2023, with worse scores.

The report observes that a "wave of autocratisation is observable globally. Autocratisation is ongoing in "42 countries, home to 2.8 billion people, or 35% of the world's population. India, with 18% of the world's population, accounts for about half of the population living in autocratising countries."



The report says, "the level of liberal democracy enjoyed by the average human in the (South Asia) region is now down to levels last seen in 1975 – almost half a century ago. That was when the Vietnam War ended and when Indira Gandhi declared a state of emergency in India." The population-weighted index puts India's 1.4 billion citizens as being under autocracy.

The report cites India as "one of the worst autocratisers lately."

The V-Dem *Liberal Democracy Index* (LDI) "captures both liberal and electoral aspects of democracy based on the 71 indicators included in the Liberal Component Index (LCI) and the Electoral Democracy Index (EDI)." India is at rank 104, with a score of .28 on this count and this has worsened over last time. Pakistan for context is at 119th rank and a score at .21

Figure 14 plots the LDI values for the top 10 "stand-alone" autocratizing countries. "Stand-alone" means that autocratization in these countries started after a period of relative stability (i.e., no substantial change on the EDI levels). This is different from bell-turn episodes of autocratization (see below). Note that the first year on the graph is technically a "pre-episode" year in the sense that the year after was the first one recording a decline by the ERT methodology. The plot visualizes the total magnitude of change during autocratization.

"This is at an experimental stage but we are sure to induct them into active service shortly to create a specialised squad to pull down rouge drones," the sources revealed.

India has not legislated over the judicial conduct of judges of Judicial conduct of Judges of constitutional courts. Acceptance of Judgeship is often an act of sacrifice for lawyers as it involves loss of freedom. Restraint becomes the norm, which also reduces the space for personal aspirations. Yet, a judge of the constitutional court gets powers and privileges which others do not enjoy. According to

Article 217 read with Article 124(4) of the Constitution, the only way to remove a judge is the almost to remove a judge is the almost unworkable method of impeachment by Parliament. Article 218 declares the High Court Article 218 declares the High Court contempt power which the judges could invole. The jurist Alan Dershowitz was right when he said that "judges are the weakest link in our system of justice, and they are also the most protected".

Judicial conduct Paragraph VIII of the Third Schedule of the Constitution demands a judge-designate to swear inter alia that he will perform his duties without fear o favour, affection or ill-will. The Bangalore Principles of Judicial Conduct (2002) gained Conduct (2002) gained international acceptance as indicated by the Judicial Integrity certain Judicial Antegrity certain Judicial values including independence, impartiality, integrity, propriety, equality, competence and diligence. It bias or prejudice in the decision-making process. It asks judges to ensure that their conduct "both in and out of the confidence of the public, the legal court maintains and enhances the confidence of the public, the legal profession, and litigants in the impartiality of the judge and of the judiciary". Clause 2.4 of the declaration is against the judge making comments "that might reasonably be expected to affect the outcome of (a case)." It says that the "judge shall disqualify himself or herself from participating in any proceedings in which the judge is unable to

decide the matter impartially". The Code also says, "A judge shall conduct himself or herself in a way that is consistent with the dignity of the judicial office". The U.S judge, Simon Rifkind, remarked that the courtroom. sooner or later, becomes the image of the judge and that it will rise or fall to the level of the presiding judge. The Supreme Court in C. Ravichandran Iyer v Justice A.M. Bhattacharjee (1995) said, "To keep the stream of justice clean and pure, the Judge character, impectable integrity and upright behaviour". In Alf India Judger Association v. Union of India (1991), the court spoke of "society's expectation from ju There have been similar instances in the past. In 1967, Justice A.M. Bhattacharjee (1995) instances in the past. In 1967, Chief Justice Koka Subba Rao resigned to contest the presidential elections, and in 1983, the Supreme Court judge Baharul Islam resigned to get elected as a member of the Rajya Sabha. But past aberrations do not justify present wrongs. They are no longer good precedents or longer good precedents or practices given the globally accepted principles of the Bangalore Declaration, which were made later.

An opportunity The present episode, therefore, gives an opportunity to the Chief justice of India and the Supreme Court to investigate the matter more seriously and evolve methods to avert such judicial aberrations. It could lead to one of the most awaited steps towards reforming the judiciary. The top court must expressly prohibit judges of constitutional courts from taking the political plunge even after they resign. Such acts should be interpreted as a breach of the oath read in the light of Indian precedents and the Indian precedents and the accepted norms on judicial conduct. There is a need for a judge-made law on the topic since Parliament will hardly act on this iscure

WHY ARE THE ACADEMY AWARDS CALLED OSCARS? MULTIPLE ANSWERS

RISHIKA SINGH NEW DELHI, MARCH 11

THE 96TH Academy Awards ceremony was held on Monday. Why are the awards called the "Oscars"?

The official website of the Academy Awards says: "Officially named the Academy Award of Merit, the statuette is better known by its nickname, Oscar, the origins of which aren't clear."

Need for a new name

The first Academy Awards ceremony was held in 1927. Bruce Davis, the Academy's Executive Director for 20 years, wrote in his book *The Academy and the Award* that a need for a short name for the award was felt by the mid-1930s.

The trade magazine *Variety* suggested calling it "The Iron Man" briefly, but the name did not find much acceptance. "The Gold Man" also had a short run.

The possible originators

Three people are often credited for the name — actor Bette Davis, librarian and later Academy Executive Director Margaret Herrick, and Hollywood gossip columnist Sidney Skolsky.

Bette Davis won the Best Actress award in 1936. She wrote in her 1962 book *The Lonely Life*: "I stared at the little gold-plated man in the palm of my hand. He was a Hollywood male, and, of course, epicene; but in a kind of madness his backview was the spit of my husband's." She was then married to Harmon Oscar Nelson.

However Bruce Davis's book records - I love Hollywood

that "Employees have affectionately dubbed their famous statuette 'Oscar."

The Hollywood columnist Sidney Skolsky, meanwhile, was apparently frustrated with the official term used to refer to the trophy — "statuette".

"I'd show them, acting so high and mighty about their prize. I'd give it...a name that would erase their phony dignity... I remembered the vaudeville shows I'd seen. The comedians having fun with the orchestra leader in the pit would say, "Will you have a cigar, Oscar?"...During the next year of columns, whenever referring to the Academy Award, I used the word 'Oscar'. In a few years, Oscar was the accepted name," Davis quoted Skolsky as writing his memoir, Don't Get Me Wrong - II ove Hollywood

Macron announces legislation for 'aid in dying', with strict conditions

ASSOCIATED PRESS PARIS, MARCH 11

FRENCH PRESIDENT Emmanuel Macron has announced new legislation to legalise "aid in dying" that will allow adults facing endof-life illness to take lethal medication, a first in the country.

The move follows last year's report indicating that most French citizens support legalising end-of-life options.

In an interview published Monday by French newspapers La Croix and Liberation, Macron said the new bill will be restricted to adults suffering from an incurable illness who are expected to die in the "short or

middle-term" and who are suffering "intractable" physical or psychological pain.

Macron said the law will offer "a possible path, in a determined situation, with precise criteria, where the medical decision is playing its role".

He gave the example of people with terminal cancer, some of whom until now have gone abroad to end their lives.

Only people aged 18 or above who are capable of forming their own views will be allowed to get in the process, meaning those with severe psychiatric conditions and neurodegenerative disorders such as Alzheimer's disease won't be eligible, Macron specified.

Patients who seek to enter the process will need to reconfirm their choice after 48 hours and they should then receive an answer from a medical team within two weeks maximum, Macron said. A doctor will then deliver a prescription, valid for three months, for the lethal medication.

People will be able to take the medication at home, at a nursing home or at a health care facility, Macron said. If their physical condition doesn't allow them to do it alone, they will be allowed to get help from someone of their choice or by a doctor or a nurse.

Macron said the new bill will refer to "aid in dying ... because it's simple and humane," rather than terms like euthanasia or medically assisted suicide.

Macron set no date for the legislation to be applied, saying it will first need to follow a months-long legislative process that will start in May.

Penicillin G and PLI Scheme

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- India will start manufacturing the common antibiotic Penicillin G in 2024, three decades after India's last plant shut down.

 APIs, also called bulk drugs, are significant ingredients in the manufacture of drugs. The Hubei province of China is the hub of the API manufacturing industry.

WHAT IS PENICILLIN G

PENICILLIN G is the active pharmaceutical ingredient (API) used in several common antibiotics. An API is the main ingredient of a drug responsible for bringing about its desired effects. Like many other APIs, Penicillin G was phased out of production in India after cheaper Chinese products flooded the market. The last plant to stop production of the antibiotic was Torrent Pharma in Ahmedabad.

ACCORDING TO the United States government's National Library of Medicine, Penicillin G is a narrow spectrum antibiotic used for the treatment of several serious bacterial infections such as pneumonia, meningitis, gonorrhea, syphilis, etc. Due to poor oral absorption, Penicillin G is generally administered intravenously or intramuscularly. Penicillin G may have some side effects in some patients.

Why did Penicillin Manufacturing Stop in India?

Closure of Manufacturing:

- Penicillin G, along with numerous other active pharmaceutical ingredients (APIs) manufactured in India, faced discontinuation due to the influx of competitively priced Chinese alternatives flooding the market.
- During the 1990s, at least five companies were engaged in the production of Penicillin G within the country. However, the significantly lower prices of Chinese counterparts **rendered Indian manufacturers economically nonviable**, leading to the closure of their operations.

• Many sizable manufacturing plants had to be liquidated for scrap.

- Additionally, the Drug Prices Control Order, which enforced price caps on essential medicines, further incentivized the adoption of cheaper imported products.
 - For Example, India initially sold Paracetamol at approximately Rs 800 per kilogram, but the entry of Chinese competitors slashed prices to nearly Rs 400 per kilogram, rendering domestic production economically unviable.

Impact of PLI Schemes:

 There has been a significant decrease in API imports following the implementation of the PLI scheme.

For example, paracetamol, the imports have halved compared to pre-pandemic levels.

 However, despite this decline, a substantial portion of APIs, particularly for antibiotics, is still imported, highlighting the need for further development in domestic API manufacturing.

- The PLI scheme offers incentives, including a 20% support for the first four years, 15% for the fifth year, and 5% for the sixth year for fermentation-based bulk drugs like antibiotics, enzymes, and hormones such as insulin.
 - These drugs, which involve fermentation in their production process, are considered more challenging to manufacture.
 - Additionally, chemically synthesised drugs are eligible for a 10% incentive over six years on eligible sales.

What is the Production Linked Incentive Scheme (PLI)?

About:

- The PLI scheme was conceived to scale up domestic manufacturing capability, accompanied by higher import substitution and employment generation.
- Launched in March 2020, the scheme initially targeted three industries:
 - Mobile and allied Component Manufacturing
 - Electrical Component Manufacturing and
 - Medical Devices.

• Success in Smartphone Manufacturing:

- In FY 2017-18, mobile phone imports were USD 3.6 billion, while exports were a mere USD 334 million, resulting in a -USD 3.3 billion trade deficit.
- By FY 2022-23, imports reduced to USD 1.6 billion, while exports surged to nearly USD 11 billion, yielding a positive net exports of USD 9.8 billion.

Asiatic Lions



- The International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN) recently recategorized the Asiatic lion status as **vulnerable** from endangered indicating a positive shift in its conservation status.
- Nomenclature change
- Due to genetic similarity between Central African, West African and Asiatic Lions, IUCN has clubbed all three under <u>**Panthera**</u> <u>**leo leo**</u>.
- Earlier, the Asiatic lions were classified as <u>*Panthera leo persica*</u>.

- About The Asiatic lion is a subspecies of lion, slightly smaller than African lions.
- They are also known as *Persian lions or Indian lions*.
- Scientific Name Panthera leo leo.
- Family Felidae.
- Distribution They used to range from Turkey, across Asia, to eastern India.
- Habitat At present <u>Gir National Park, Gujarat</u> is the only abode of the Asiatic lion.
- They are one of the 5 <u>big cats</u> found in India and are better known as 'the king of beasts

What is Indelible Ink and how does it work?

Indelible ink is a <u>special purple colour</u> ink used to mark voters during elections to <u>prevent duplicate voting</u>. It is typically applied to a voter's finger after they cast their vote and is designed to be long-lasting and resistant to removal. It often <u>contains silver nitrate</u>, which reacts with the skin and on exposure to light, forms a <u>permanent dark mark</u>. The ink works by <u>penetrating the skin and staining it</u>, making it difficult to wash off or remove with solvents.

'NITLfor States' Platform

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The <u>'NITI for States' platform</u>, a <u>digital initiative aimed at</u> <u>empowering states and union territories (UTs)</u> in achieving <u>national</u> <u>development goals</u> was launched recently.
