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


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

China 'decisive enabler' of Russia's war, says NATO

WASHINGTON

Leaders of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) nations on Thursday looked to bolster ties with Asian partners after slamming China as a "decisive enabler" of Russia's war, before holding talks with Ukraine's President Volodymyr Zelenskyy at the end of a summit in Washington. The 32-nation alliance has used the pomp-filled set piece in the U.S. capital to showcase its resolve against Moscow and backing for Kyiv.

After spending the bulk of the summit focused on bolstering Ukraine, NATO shifted attention eastwards by welcoming the leaders of Australia, Japan, New Zealand and South Korea.

A declaration from NA-TO released on Wednesday called Beijing a "decisive enabler of Russia's war against Ukraine" through its supplies of dual-use goods such as microchips that can help Moscow's military. China "cannot enable the largest war in Europe in recent history without this negatively impacting its interests and reputation," it said.

Beijing hit back by warning NATO to "stop hyping up the so-called China threat and provoking confrontation and rivalry".

China presents itself as a neutral party in the conflict, but it has however offered a critical lifeline to

The United States has been pushing its European allies for years to pay closer attention to the challenges posed by China.

The Washington sum-

mit is the third such gathering attended by leaders from the four Asia-Pacific partners. The U.S. announced it would begin "episodic deployments" of long-range missiles to Germany in 2026. The White House said it would even-

tually look to permanently station them in Germany, and the missiles would "have significantly longer range" than current U.S. systems in Europe.

'Bringing chaos to Asia' China accused NATO of seeking security at the ex-

pense of others and told the alliance not to bring the same "chaos" to Asia.

"NATO hyping up China's responsibility on the Ukraine issue is unreasonable and has sinister motives," Foreign Ministry spokesperson Lin Jian said. He said China has a fair and objective stance on the Ukraine issue.






Finland Becomes 31st Member of NATO

The Kerala High Court has observed that a man who was not a legally wedded partner of a woman cannot be prosecuted for the offence of cruelty under Section 498 (A) of the India Penal Code (IPC) as he does not come under the definition of husband in the Section.

Justice A. Badharudeen made the observation recently while quashing a case registered against a live-in partner on a complaint of a woman.

The court observed that



Marriage is the constituent which takes the woman's partner to the status of her husband, says Kerala HC.

the term "husband" means a married man, a woman's partner in marriage. Thus, the marriage was the constituent which takes the woman's partner to the status of her husband. Marriage means a marriage in the eye of the law. Thus, without legal marriage, if a man becomes a woman's partner, he will not be covered by the term 'husband' under Section 498(A) of IPC.

The allegation against the man was that, while the woman was maintaining a live-in relationship with the accused, during the period from March 13, 2023 to August 20, 2023 at his house, he mentally and physically harassed her.

Carrying 1,930 containers, *San Fernando* becomes first mothership to dock at Kerala's Vizhinjam port

THIRUVANANTHAPURAM

Scripting a new chapter in the maritime history of the country, the first mothership carrying cargo from the Xiamen port in China called at the Vizhinjam international seaport, India's first deep-water container transshipment port, on Thursday morning.

The Marshall Island-flagged container ship *San Fernando*, owned by SFL Corporation Ltd. and chartered by Maersk (AP Moller Group), Denmark, is managed and operated by Bernhard Schulte Ship Management, Singapore.

Adani Port pilots boarded the ship carrying 1,930

containers around 7.45 a.m. when the ship reached the passage leading to the berth. The ship was then navigated through the buoyed channel to enter the tranquil breakwater area inside the

port. The ship turned around before the tugs pushed it to the berth and moved the ship to the wharf with mooring ropes.

Four tugs were pressed in to bring the ship to the berth. Three tugs were involved in pushing the ship forward and pulling the aft, or *vice versa*, to turn the ship to get the bow facing out and then aligned the ship with the berth before the tugs finally pushed the ship to berth. The ship's bow thruster and the power from the main engine were also used for the berthing.

The vessel was set to begin the work of offloading 1,930 containers by around 2 p.m.

Water salute

The ship was also accorded a water salute at the port. The ship will leave for Colombo on Friday after the official reception planned by the State government to be attended by Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan, Union Shipping Minister Sarbananda Sonowal, and others.

The work on the ₹7,700-crore port project, one of the major flagship infrastructure projects promoted by the Kerala government with the Adani Group in the public-private partnership (PPP) mode, started on December 5, 2015.

However, the project, which was scheduled to be commissioned in 2019, got delayed and missed several deadlines due to various reasons. The trial run of the port will officially begin on July 12, ahead of the revised scheduled commissioning in December 2024.



Indian ship crew win 'exceptional bravery' awards for Red Sea rescue

Captain Avhilash Rawat and his crew of an oil tanker have been named among the winners of the International Maritime Organisation (IMO) 2024 Award for Exceptional Bravery at Sea for their "extraordinary courage" shown in a Red Sea rescue mission.

Captain Rawat and his crew were declared winners by the IMO on Wednesday for the "determination and endurance" demonstrated while coordinating firefighting and The crew were given the award by the International Maritime Organisation

damage control efforts to combat a fire that broke out after an anti-ship missile reportedly fired by Iranian-backed Houthi rebels struck their vessel 'Marlin Luanda' earlier this year.

Captain Brijesh Nambiar and the crew of the Indian Navy ship *INS Visakhapatnam* have been conferred a Letter of Commendation for their sup-

port to the oil tanker when in distress.

"On the evening of J26 January 2024, the Marlin Luanda, carrying 84,147 tonnes of Naphtha, was en route from Suez to Incheon when it was struck by an anti-ship ballistic missile. The explosion ignited a cargo tank, creating a significant fire hazard with flames exceeding 5 meters," reads the award citation.

"Despite the damage, Captain Avhilash Rawat swiftly organised firefighting efforts, ensuring the crew's safety and maintaining the ship's navigability amidst the chaos. With the starboard lifeboat destroyed, the remaining crew mustered at the port lifeboat station, ready for potential evacuation," it added.

Despite the extreme danger and the constant threat of further attacks, Captain Rawat and his crew fought the fire using fixed foam monitors and portable hoses. The fire continued to spread, particularly affecting an adjacent tank, but the crew managed to contain it using seawater after foam supplies were exhausted, the IMO said.

Why location sharing can't be bail condition

THE SUPREME COURT on Monday held that courts cannot impose bail conditions that require accused persons to share their location on Google Maps.

A Bench comprising Justices Abhay S Oka and Ujjal Bhuyan also held that in cases where the accused is a foreign national, courts cannot demand a "certificate of assurance" from relevant Embassies or High Commissions that the accused will not leave the country.

On May 31, 2022, the Delhi High Court granted bail to Nigerian national Frank Vitus in a drug smuggling case, subject to the condition that he and co-accused Ebera Nwanaforo "shall drop a PIN on the Google map to ensure that their location is available to the Investigation Officer of the case". They were

also required to obtain a certificate of assurance from the High Commission of Nigeria saying they would not leave the country.

Why did the SC reject Delhi HC's unusual conditions?

After considering an affidavit submitted by Google which clarified that sharing a pinned location "does not enable real-time tracking of

the user or their device", the SC held that the condition imposed was "completely redundant" as it does not help authorities track the accused persons.

The court also held that "any bail condition which enables the Police/Investigation Agency to track every movement of the accused by using any technology or otherwise would undoubtedly violate the right to privacy guaranteed under Article 21". The court then ordered the removal of this condition.

On the subject of the "certificate of assurance", the court held that the grant of such a certificate is "beyond the control of the accused", and ordered the removal of this condition as well. It stated that if the Embassy does not grant such a certificate within a reasonable time, the accused "cannot be denied bail" on the basis of a condition which is simply "impossible for the accused to comply with".

What was the case about?

In May 2014, Vitus, Nwanaforo, and one Eric Jayden were arrested in Mahipalpur,

Delhi by Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) officials who claimed to have received "secret information" regarding a consignment of drugs. According to the NCB, the three were in a taxi at the time, and Jayden was found carrying a bag containing 1.9 kg of Methamphetamine.

Vitus and Nwanaforo argued in court that

there was no incriminating evidence on their person. They said that they had been incarcerated for eight years, and were thus entitled to bail as per the SC's directions in Supreme Court Legal Aid Committee Representing Undertrial Prisoners vs Union of India & Ors (1994).

In this case, the SC had held that when there is a delay in disposing of cases under the NDPS Act, if the accused is charged with an offence punishable with 10 years' imprisonment or more, they "shall be released on bail if he has been in jail for not less than five years provided he furnishes bail in the sum of Rupees one lakh with two sureties for like amount". Other "general conditions" included, in the case of foreign nationals, obtaining a "certificate of assurance" from the relevant Embassy stating that they will not leave the country.

In line with this, the Delhi HC granted bail to Vitus and Nwanaforo, but added the requirement of submitting their Google Maps pin.



- What is RBI's financial inclusion index?
- In 2021, the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) launched a Financial Inclusion Index (FI-Index) to track the process of ensuring access to financial services, timely and adequate credit for vulnerable groups such as weaker sections and low-income groups at an affordable cost.

- The index incorporates the details of banking, investment, insurance, postal, and pension sectors in consultation with government and respective sector regulators.
- The FI-Index has been constructed without any 'base year'. The FI-Index is published annually in July.



Range and Parameters of FI-Index

- The index captures information on various aspects of financial inclusion in a single value ranging between 0 and 100, where 0 represents complete financial exclusion and 100 indicates full financial inclusion.
- The FI-Index comprises three broad parameters, access (35%), usage (45%), and quality (20%), with each of these consisting of various dimensions, which are computed based on a number of indicators.

Durand Cup Tournament



Durand Cup Tournament

- Skinner's estrangement from her family lasted until Munro's death, and she ultimately shared her story to shed light on the hidden darkness behind Munro's celebrated literary career.

- Ethical Issues involved in the case:
- 1. Failure to Protect: Alice Munro did not protect her daughter from abuse despite knowing about it.
- 2. Silent Acquiescence: Munro's choice to remain silent and support her abuser over her daughter.
- 3. Victim Blaming: Fremlin blamed Skinner for the abuse, and Munro did not challenge this narrative.

- 1. <u>Complicity</u>: Munro's family and others close to the situation did not take action to stop the abuse or support Skinner initially.
- 2. Prioritizing Personal Needs: Munro prioritized her own relationship with Fremlin over her daughter's well-being.
- 3. Abuse of Power: Fremlin used his position of trust as a stepfather to abuse Skinner.
- **4. Public Deception**: The true nature of Munro's family life was hidden, potentially misleading the public about her character.
- **5.Long-term Trauma**: The prolonged impact of abuse on Skinner and the lack of support from her mother and family.

- Course of Action:
- 1. Therapy and Counseling: Ensure continued psychological support for Skinner to help her heal.
- 2. Public Apology: The Munro family should issue a public apology acknowledging past mistakes and supporting Skinner's account.
- 3. Advocate for Victims: Use Munro's literary legacy to raise awareness about sexual abuse and advocate for victims' rights.

- 1. <u>Family Reconciliation</u>: Encourage ongoing dialogue within the family to rebuild trust and support Skinner.
- 2.<u>Legal Review:</u> Review any remaining legal actions to ensure justice and closure for Skinner.
- 3. <u>Educational Outreach</u>: Support programs and initiatives that educate the public about the importance of protecting and supporting abuse victims.
- **4. Establish a Fund:** Create a fund or foundation in Munro's name to support abuse survivors and promote mental health services

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


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
