



Renowned scientist and former ISRO Chairman Kasturirangan dies at 84

BENGALURU

Former ISRO Chairman Dr. K. Kasturirangan passed away in Bengaluru on Friday. He was 84.

The ISRO, in a statement, said he died at 10.43 a.m. at his residence. His body will be kept at the Raman Research Institute from 10 a.m. on Sunday.

According to an ISRO statement: "Dr. K. Kasturirangan has left for heavenly abode this morning at 10. 43 am at his residence in Bengaluru. His body will be kept at the Raman Research Institute (RRI) in Bengaluru for paying last respects on Sunday April 27th from 1000-1200 hrs."

Dr.Kasturirangan is survived by his sons Rajesh Rangan and Sanjay Ran-

gan. Sources said his health was deteriorating the past week.

Dr. Kasturirangan served as the fifth chairman of ISRO between 1994-2003, and also as the Secretary, Department of Space for over nine years.

During his four-decadelong career in ISRO, he was part of several key missions. He was the project director of India's first two experimental earth observation satellites BHASKA-RA-I & II. He steered the first operational Indian Remote Sensing satellite IRS-1A.

A recipient of Padma Shri, Padma Bhushan, and Padma Vibhushan, Dr. Kasturirangan got his Bachelor of Science with Honours and Master of Science degrees in Physics from Bombay University. He received his Doctorate Degree in Experimental High Energy Astronomy in 1971 while working at the Physical Research Laboratory, Ahmedabad.

Dr. Kasturirangan served as a member of the Rajya Sabha, and was a member of the Planning Commission during the UPA government.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi, in his condolence message, called Dr. Kasturirangan "a towering figure in India's scientific and educational journey".



Copyright case: Rahman, *PS-II* makers told to deposit ₹2 cr.

The Delhi High Court on Friday directed renowned music director and composer A.R. Rahman, along with the co-producers of the film *Ponniyin Selvan-II*, to deposit ₹2 crore with the court registry over an alleged copyright infringement related to the song *Veera Raja Veera* featured in the 2023 film. The order came on a lawsuit by classical vocalist Ustad Faiyaz Wasifuddin Dagar, who accused Mr. Rahman and the film's production houses of unauthorised use of a classical composition titled *Shiva Stuti*, originally composed by the Junior Dagar Brothers, the late Ustad N. Faiyazuddin Dagar and the late Ustad Zahiruddin Dagar.

Ordered A.R. Rahman and co-producers of **Ponniyin Selvan-II (2023)** to deposit **₹2 crore** with the court registry.

DRDO makes headway in hypersonic technology

NEW DELHI

The Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) on Friday announced a significant milestone in the field of hypersonic weapon technology with the demonstration of long-duration Active Cooled Scramjet Subscale Combustor ground testing for more than 1,000 seconds.

"The ground-test is in continuation of the earlier test reported for 120 seconds in January 2025. With the successful test, the system will be soon ready for full-scale flightworthy combustor testing," the DRDO said in a statement. "This test validates the design of long duration scramjet combustor as well as test facility."

The development was achieved by the Defence Research & Development Laboratory, a Hyderabadbased laboratory of DRDO.

Hypersonic cruise missile is a class of weapon that can travel more than five times the speed of sound (>6,100 kmph) for a long duration and is powered by air breathing engine. Newsom: California is now world's 4th-biggest economy, pips Japan

alifornia governor
Gavin Newsom boasted that his state has become the world's fourth-largest economy, following only the US, China and Germany in global rankings.

The state's nominal GDP reached \$4.1 trillion last year, edging past Japan's \$4.02 trillion, Newsom said, citing newly released IMF country-level data and preliminary state data



from US Bureau of Economic Analysis.

"California isn't just keeping pace with the world

— we're setting the pace," Newsom said. "Our economy is thriving because we invest in people, prioritise sustainability and believe in the power of innovation." The Democratic governor is leveraging the state's economic heft to challenge President Trump's trade and other policies, portraying California as a global economic force positioned to resist federal actions he says could harm key industries.

California's economy accounts for about 14% of US GDP, with realty, finance and technology sectors among top contributors, according to Public Policy Institute of California. After years of declines, California's population grew

by roughly 250,000 people last year, driven by a rebound in births and gains from international migration. Newsom has argued the state has the most to lose from tariffs because of the size of its industries. Last week, he sued Trump govt over his tariff hikes, arguing the Republican president lacks the authority to implement it without congressional approval. He vowed to negotiate with foreign leaders to spare California businesses from retaliatory tariffs.

"While we celebrate this success, we recognise that our progress is threatened by the reckless tariff policies of the federal administration," said Newsom, a potential presidential candidate in 2028. "California's economy powers the nation, and it must be protected."

IMF this weekhas sharply lowered forecasts for world growth this year and next, warning the outlook could further deteriorate as Trump's tariffs spark a global trade spat.



Developing non-vector carrying mosquito species have also potential to reduce threats.

RTS,S/ASO1 (RTS,S) is the only vaccine to show that it can significantly reduce malaria.

SE Asia, E-Mediterranean, W-Pacific, and the Americas are at risk

India represents 3% of the global malaria burden. India has shown a reduction in reported malaria cases of 49% and deaths of 50.5% compared with 2017.
