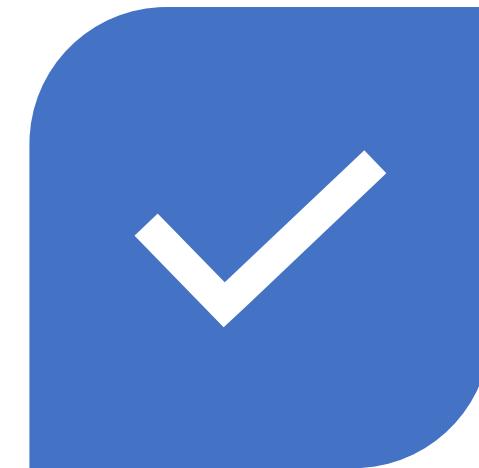

## Explosion in illegal Meghalaya mine kills 18

The explosion was likely caused by dynamite and has trapped several persons, police said

**A**n explosion in an illegally operated rat-hole coal mine in Meghalaya's East Jaintia Hills district on Thursday, officials said.

This is one of the biggest mining-related tragedies in the state. The National Green Tribunal (NGT) had banned the hazardous mining method.

Expressing condolences to the families of the victims, Meghalaya Chief Minister Conrad K. Sangma said the government would conduct an inquiry. "Accountability will be fixed, and those responsible will be held to strict action," he said. He also said that the government had received an express report of 18 bodies recovered from the site and confirmed that an explosion,

suspected to have been caused by dynamite, had trapped several persons at an unanticipated depth.

After a massive rescue and disaster response operation and recovered 18 bodies, the police reached the site on Thursday, officials said.

CM has promised action following one of the worst mining tragedies in the State since 2012

when a coal mine in East Jaintia Hills district collapsed, killing at least 15 miners.

On April 22, 2014, 18 miners died in a flooded coal mine in East Jaintia Hills district.

On Jan. 24, 2015, six miners

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## Kuki-Zo groups boycott tribal MLAs in Manipur govt., accuse them of 'betrayal'

Kuki-Zo tribal groups declared a socio-political strike against the Kuki-Zo legislators who have joined the recently formed Manipur government, led by former Manipur chief minister Biju Patnaik.

There were reports of mass strikes and shutdowns across the hills inhabited by the Kuki-Zo people, to protest "betrayal" by these MLAs, who were elected hours before the seventh session of the 12th Manipur Assembly with an

address by Governor Ajay Kumar Singh.

Normal life was disrupted in Manipur on Wednesday, and two legislators – former Deputy Chief Minister L. K. Khanta and Ngarun Sanjee – were forced to flee with other NDA legislators. All three are RJD legislators.

First visit: It was the first visit by any Kuki-Zo MLA to the State capital since the ethnic conflict between the Kuki-Zo and Meitei communities.

## Procurement of minor forest produce dips 92% in 2024-25

Government procurement of minor forest produce (MFP) at minimum support price (MSP) saw a sharp dip in 2024-25 compared to the year before, with data tabled in parliament on Thursday. According to the data, MFP procured across 19 States dropped by over 92% from 2023-24 to 2024-25. Tribal Affairs Minister Jitendra Singh said in the Lok Sabha on a question on MFP procurement by Wayanad MP Priyanka Gandhi Vadra. The leader had reportedly carried a reward of ₹8 lakh on his head, based on a tip-off about the presence of Singh and other armed Maoists in a forested, hilly area near the Dantewada district. The Dantewada Police Reserve Gistles, Bijapur, and CGPRA personnel took part in the operation, Bijapur Superintendent of Police Jitendra Yadav said.

## SC flags States' preference for 'ad-hoc' DGP appointments

CJI-led Bench says States are opting for 'Acting' police chiefs of their choice in violation of 2006 verdict, directs UPSC to approach top court if process for appointing regular DGPs is delayed

The Supreme Court on Thursday observed that States were violating appointment of regular Directors-General of Police (DGPs) with a fixed tenure of two years by opting for "acting" police chiefs of their choice in violation of a 2006 top court judgment.

The court, in a 2006 judgment in the Prakash Singh case, had made it clear that the office of DGP should be reserved for political or other external pressures and cautioned governments against naming police and law enforcement.

It had invoked an exception to Article 142 to direct the DGPs must be selected by senior ranking police and senior-most and senior-most officers, emanating from the Commission of Public Service Commission (UPSC).

The court had thrown out the concept of Acting DGPs, it had said that State police chiefs should have a minimum fixed tenure of two years.

Subsequent top court orders in July 2018 and March 2019 detailed the appointments mechanism, which included the State concerned sending a memorandum of the relevant ministry to the UPSC.

The UPSC would prepare a panel of suitable officers and send it to the concerned State, which would then forward the proposal only when it wants to appoint a certain officer, Chief Justice K. Santosh Kumar said.

The court said many meritorious and senior police officers had lost their opportunities to be appointed as DGPs owing to the "inordinate delay" shown by State governments to send proposals to the UPSC.

The Bench was hearing the case of Telangana, where the UPSC and the

regular DGP retired after nine years ago, in November 2007. The State had not forwarded any proposal to initiate the appointment of a regular DGP, choosing to carry on with an Acting DGP.

The court said the UPSC should not fall into the trap of the States. The Bench directed the Commission to take steps to ensure timely proposals for appointment of regular DGPs.

The Bench gave the UPSC liberty to approach the Supreme Court in case the State chose to ignore such communication.

The court said many meritorious and senior police officers had lost their opportunities to be appointed as DGPs owing to the "inordinate delay" shown by State governments to send proposals to the UPSC.

The UPSC informed a Bench headed by Justice D. Y. Chandrachud that the court's earlier order was a "vacuous lapse" in the part of Telangana in not sending the proposal to the UPSC. It gave the Commission four weeks to hold meetings and make the recommendations to the Telangana government on the appointment of a regular DGP.

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## UPSC adds more norms for Civil Services aspirants

The Union Public Services Commission has expanded the conditions for appearing for the Civil Services Examination from 2026 for candidates who are serving in the Indian Police Service or any other Central Services group "A", and the notification will be issued on Wednesday.

The notification said that the UPSC will not be allowed to appear in CSE 2026 or any subsequent year if the aspirant resigns from the allocated service.

The notification said that such a candidate should join the training for "foundation course only".

Further, the notification said that the aspirant would not be allowed to appear in CSE 2028 or any subsequent year if the aspirant resigns from the allocated service.

The notification said that the conditions will apply to those allocated PS or any "Group A" service.

**One-time opportunity** The notification said that aspirants who had been affected by any service ban in CSE 2026 or earlier years, would have "a one-time opportunity to appear either in this year's examination or the one for the aspirant to resign from their service.

If their aim was to use the one-time opportunity for CSE 2028 or subsequent exams, they would have to follow the migration rule.

The notification added that the candidate would be eligible for grants of one-time opportunity on joining the training in order to enable him/her to appear in CSE 2027. It ad-



# UPSC adds more norms for Civil Services aspirants

The Union Public Services Commission has expanded the restrictions on applying for the Civil Services Examination from 2026 for candidates who are allotted the Indian Police Service or any other Central Services Group "A", said the notification for the 2026 exam issued on Wednesday.

The notification said the UPSC was looking to fill approximately 933 vacancies this year, of which 33 would be reserved for Persons with Benchmark Disability.

While keeping the restrictions for those already allotted the Indian Administrative Service or the Indian Foreign Service in past CSEs unchanged, it introduced a set of conditions. A candidate allotted any of these services in the CSE 2026 would be eligible for the CSE 2027 if they are granted an exemption from training for that service by the "authority concerned".

The notification added that the candidate would be eligible for grant of one-time exemption only from joining the training in order to enable him/her to appear in CSE-2027. It ad-

ded that such a candidate should join the training for "foundation course only".

Further, the notification said that such candidates would not be allowed to appear in CSE 2028 or any subsequent CSEs "unless he/she resigns from the allotted service".

**One-time opportunity**  
The notification said that candidates who had been allotted any service based on CSE 2025 or earlier years, would have "a one-time opportunity" to appear either in this year's examination or the one for 2027 without having to resign from their service.

If their aim was to use their remaining attempts for CSE 2028 or subsequent exams, they would have to follow the resignation rule, the UPSC said.

The notification said that this set of conditions would apply to those being allotted Indian Police Service or any Central Service categorised as Group A.

# SC flags States' preference for 'ad-hoc' DGP appointments

CJI-led Bench says States are opting for 'Acting' police chiefs of their choice in violation of 2006 verdict, directs UPSC to approach top court if process for appointing regular DGPs is delayed

**T**he Supreme Court on Thursday observed that States were avoiding appointment of regular Directors-General of Police (DGPs) with a fixed tenure of two years, opting instead for "Acting" police chiefs of their choice in violation of a 20-year-old top court judgment.

The court, in a 2006 judgment in the *Prakash Singh* case, had made it clear that the office of DGP should be divorced from political or other external pressures and cautioned governments against mixing politics and law enforcement.

It had invoked its extraordinary powers under Article 142 to direct that DGPs must be selected by States from among the three senior-most and meritorious officers empanelled by the Union Public Service Commission (UPSC). The court had thrown out the "concept" of Acting DGPs. It had held that State police chiefs should have a minimum fixed tenure of two years.

Subsequent top court orders in July 2018 and March 2019 detailed the appointments mechanism, which included the State concerned sending a proposal to the UPSC three months ahead of the retirement of the incumbent DGP. The UPSC would prepare a panel of suitable officers. The State would appoint one of the empanelled officers as DGP "immediately".

On Thursday, the UPSC informed a Bench headed by Chief Justice of India Surya Kant that the reality on the ground hardly resembled the process envisaged in the 2006 judgment.

The Bench was hearing the case of Telangana, where the UPSC said the

last regular DGP retired about nine years ago, in November 2017. The State had not forwarded any proposals to initiate the appointment of a regular DGP, choosing to carry on with "Acting" DGPs. "A State will send a proposal only when it wants to appoint a certain officer," Chief Justice Kant said.

## Meritorious officers

The court said many meritorious and senior police officers had lost their opportunity at becoming DGPs owing to the "inordinate delay" shown by State governments to send proposals to the UPSC. "There are several States which keep on delaying the submission of proposals for

appointment of regular DGPs in total disregard of the direction of the Supreme Court in the *Prakash Singh* case... An ad-hoc arrangement by appointing an Acting DGP is preferred," the Bench observed.

The court said the UPSC should not fall into ploys of the States. The Bench directed the Commission to write to States to send timely proposals for appointment of regular DGPs whenever such an occasion arises in the future. The Bench gave the UPSC liberty to approach the Supreme Court in case the States chose to ignore such communication.

"Then necessary consequences, including accountability of those responsible for the delay would follow," the court observed in its order.

Noting that there was a "serious lapse" on the part of Telangana in not sending a timely proposal to the UPSC, it gave the Commission four weeks to hold meetings and make the recommendations to the Telangana government on the appointment of a regular DGP.

# India, GCC nations sign terms of reference for FTA

Appropriate that we enter a robust trading arrangement for greater free flow of goods and services, and predictability, stability to policy: Goyal

Representatives of India and the six-nation Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) on Thursday signed the Terms of Reference for negotiations on a free trade agreement (FTA). The GCC countries are together India's largest merchandise trade partners, with total merchandise trade exceeding that done with even the EU and the U.S.

The Terms of Reference (ToR) were signed by India's chief negotiator for the FTA, Additional Secretary Ajay Bhadoo, and his counterpart representing the Secretariat General of the Gulf Cooperation Council, Raja Al Marzouki. The signing of the ToR is a necessary precursor for the start of formal negotiations. The GCC countries

are Bahrain, Kuwait, Oman, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, and the UAE.

"It is most appropriate that we now enter into a much stronger and robust trading arrangement, which will enable a greater free flow of goods and services, bring predictability and stability to policy, help encourage greater degree of investments and take our bilateral relations between the six nation GCC

group and India to greater heights," Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal, who presided over the signing, said in his speech.

## Bilateral benefit

Mr. Goyal pointed out that the two sides could significantly benefit from each other, with India's workforce both within the GCC countries as well as in India standing to gain from the eventual agreement.

"The GCC countries can help us with further diversification and growth of our energy sources, opportunities for our youth, and massive amounts of investments that different countries have already committed at different points of time, which will further get an impetus with a free trade agreement between India and the GCC nations," he added.

# India, GCC agree on terms of free trade agreement

**INDIA AND THE** six-nation Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) on Thursday signed the terms of reference (ToR) for a free trade agreement (FTA), setting the framework for negotiations that would follow.

The discussions on the FTA with GCC have been going on for two decades and now finally reached the ToR stage, ready to take-off more than two decades after the first attempt was made.

The ToR establishes the framework, scope, objectives, and procedures for the negotiations. The signing of ToR is the first step for negotiations to begin.


"It is most appropriate that we now enter into a much stronger and robust trading arrangement which will enable greater free flow of goods and services, bring predictability and stability to policy, help encourage greater degree of investments and take our bilateral relations between the six nation GCC group and India to greater heights," Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal said at the signing of the ToR.

because when it comes to just goods trade the GCC — that includes Saudi Arabia, United Arab Emirates, Oman, Qatar, Bahrain and Kuwait — is India's biggest partner.

The bilateral trade between two sides totalled \$178.56 billion in 2024-25 with India's exports at \$58.87 billion and imports at \$121.68 billion.

The agreement with the GCC will further strengthen our relations both on geopolitical and trading elements, will help draw greater amounts of investments, create job opportunities, encourage the food security and

energy security of both the GCC nations and India, the minister added.

"We already have about 10 million Indians living and working in the GCC region, helping power the economies of the GCC and working as a living bridge between our societies, between our nations," he added.

Among the GCC nations, India already has signed FTAs with UAE, Oman and is in discussions with Qatar for laying the ground for negotiations to begin. Even with Bahrain, draft ToR has been exchanged for initiation of negotiations on the Comprehensive Economic Part-

nership Agreement (CEPA).

In August 2004, India and GCC signed a Framework Agreement on Economic Cooperation, paving the way for FTA talks. In 2006 and 2008, two rounds of negotiations were held. In 2009, the GCC deferred its negotiations with all countries.

The UAE is India's biggest trade partner in the GCC with bilateral trade of \$100 billion followed by Saudi Arabia at \$41.8 billion. It is an important source of Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) with inflows totalling \$31 billion between April 2000 and September 2025.




