Procurement of minor forest produce dips 92% in 2024-25

Government procurement of minor forest produce (MFP) at minimum support price (MSP) saw a sharp dip in 2024-25 compared to the year before, with data tabled in Parliament on Thursday showing that the amount of MFP procured across 16 States dropped by over 92% from 2023-24 to 2024-25. Tribal Affairs Minister Jitendra Singh tabled the data in response to a question on MFP procurement by Wayanad MP Piyankha Ganesh Vadra. Mr. Singh said that the Tribal Affairs Ministry had, till date, released ₹30.65 crore to State governments for the procurement of MFP at MSP.

Senior Maoist leader killed in Chhattisgarh's Bijapur

A senior leader of the banned Communist Party of India (Maoist) was gunned down by the security forces in Bijapur district of Chhattisgarh on Thursday, the police said. Ashim Singh, divisional committee member of the South Bihar Division, had been with the outfit for over 20 years, a police officer said, adding that he carried a reward of ₹5 lakh on his head. Based on a tip-off about the presence of Singh and other armed Maoists in a forested, hilly area under the Forest police DCPs, the Forest Police, District Reserve Guards, Bijapur, and COBRA personnel took part in the operation, Bijapur Superintendent of Police Jitendra Yadav said.

NHRC notice over alleged exploitation, forced religious conversion of women at gyms

The National Human Rights Commission (NHRC) on Wednesday issued notice to the Chief Secretaries of all States and Union Territories, the Union Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Sports, and the Sports Authority of India over allegations of exploitation and forced religious conversion of women at gyms and fitness centres.

The notice was issued by NHRC member Prakash Karan Singh who said that numerous cases of sexual exploitation of women targeted by trainers in gyms and fitness clubs had come to light from various places across the country. "Additionally, from a health perspective as well, unstandardised food supplements and uncontrolled

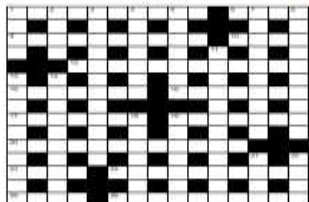

physical activities also pose a threat to human life. Therefore, notices have been issued to all State governments, the Ministry of Sports and Youth Affairs, and sports authorities, summoning information regarding the rules and guidelines related to the establishment/operation of gym/fitness centres. So that steps can be taken in the direction of controlling unwholesome activities in the sector," he wrote on X.

The notice came on the complaint filed by a Mirzapur (Uttar Pradesh) resident who alleged that an organised racket was being

run under the cover of a gym and fitness centre to exploit young women for exploitation and forced religious conversions. The complainant cited media emergency notices issued by the police where it was alleged that police were in glare with the activities. The police intervention to prevent such activities to prevent an "abuse of authority, failure of law enforcement, and violation of human rights, women's safety and sports activities," the complainant sought the intervention of the Commission. Taking cognizance of the complaint under Section 12 of the Protection of Human Rights Act, 1993, the bench directed the Chief Secretaries of all States and Union Territories to form guideline cells to form guidelines and standards for gym establishments/fitness centres etc. in the State.

MSF raises concerns over FTA impact on medicines in India

Médecins Sans Frontières (MSF), an international aid organisation that provides emergency medical assistance to populations in distress in more than 80 countries, has written to the European Union expressing its concern over the recently announced EU-India Free Trade Agreement. The group said that the proposed restrictive provisions will have major consequences for access to medicines in India and the rest of the developing world. "We are concerned that the EU-India FTA may contain provisions with dire consequences for access to medicines in India and the rest of the developing world," MSF said in a letter to the European

Commissioner for Trade. "They will strengthen and extend the monopoly rights of multinational pharmaceutical companies at the expense of patients in India and beyond," the group warned. MSF has specifically expressed concern over data exclusivity that could effectively block compulsory licensing, patent term extensions,仿制药,仿制药,仿制药 and border measures that seek to detain imports or exports of good suspected of infringing intellectual property rights. SC flags States' preference for 'ad-hoc' DGP appointments

Unfed Bench says States are opting for Acting police chiefs of their choice in violation of 2006 verdict, directs UPSC to approach top court if process for appointing regular DGPs is delayed

The Supreme Court on Thursday observed that States were avoiding appointment of regular Directors General of Police (DGPs) with a fixed tenure of two years, opting instead for 'Acting' police chiefs of their choice in violation of a 20-year-old top court judgment.

The court, in a 2006 judgment in the Prakash Singh case, had made it clear that the office of DGP should be divorced from political or other external pressures and cautioned governments against mixing politics and law enforcement.

It had invoked its extraordinary powers under Article 142 to direct that DGPs must be selected by States from among 25-30 senior-most and meritorious officers sponsored by the Union Public Service Commission (UPSC). The court had thrown out the "concepts" of "senior-most" and "meritorious" officers, stating that State police chiefs should have a minimum fixed tenure of two years.



Subsequent top court orders in July 2018 and March 2019 detailed the appointments mechanism, which included the State concerned sending a proposal to the UPSC three months ahead of the retirement of the incumbent DGP. The UPSC would prepare a panel of suitable officers. The State would appoint one of the empowered officers as DGP "immediately". On Thursday, the UPSC informed a Bench headed by Chief Justice of India Surya Kant that the reality on the ground hardly permitted the process envisaged in the Prakash Singh case.

The Bench was hearing the case of Telangana, where the UPSC said the last regular DGP retired about nine years ago, in November 2017. The State had not forwarded any proposal to initiate the appointment of a regular DGP, choosing to carry on with 'Acting' DGPs. "A 20-year-old process is in place only when it works to appoint a certain officer," the court observed in its order. # UPSC adds more norms for Civil Services aspirants

NEW DELHI

The Union Public Services Commission has expanded the restrictions on applying for the Civil Services Examination from 2026 for candidates who are allotted the Indian Police Service or any other Central Services Group "A", said the notification for the 2026 exam issued on Wednesday.

The notification said the UPSC was looking to fill approximately 933 vacancies this year, of which 33 would be reserved for Persons with Benchmark Disability.

While keeping the restrictions for those already allotted the Indian Administrative Service or the Indian Foreign Service in past CSEs unchanged, it introduced a set of conditions. A candidate allotted any of these services in the CSE 2026 would be eligible for the CSE 2027 if they are granted an exemption from training for that service by the "authority concerned".

The notification added that the candidate would be eligible for grant of one-time exemption only from joining the training in order to enable him/her to appear in CSE-2027. It ad-

ded that such a candidate should join the training for "foundation course only".

Further, the notification said that such candidates would not be allowed to appear in CSE 2028 or any subsequent CSEs "unless he/she resigns from the allocated service".

**One-time opportunity**

The notification said that candidates who had been allotted any service based on CSE 2025 or earlier years, would have "a one-time opportunity" to appear either in this year's examination or the one for 2027 without having to resign from their service.

If their aim was to use their remaining attempts for CSE 2028 or subsequent exams, they would have to follow the resignation rule, the UPSC said.

The notification said that this set of conditions would apply to those being allotted Indian Police Service or any Central Service categorised as Group A.

"Then necessary consequences, including accountability of those responsible for the delay would follow," the court observed in its order.

Noting that there was a "serious lapse" on the part of Telangana in not sending a timely proposal to the UPSC, it gave the Commission four weeks to hold meetings and make the recommendations to the Telangana government on the appointment of a regular DGP.

## Tata Motors Passenger Vehicles posts ₹3,483 cr. loss

Tata Motors Passenger Vehicles on Thursday reported a consolidated net loss of ₹3,483 crore for the third quarter ended December 2025, impacted significantly by the cyber incident at its British arm, Jaguar Land Rover. The company had posted a consolidated net profit of ₹5,485 crore in the corresponding quarter of the last fiscal. Consolidated total revenue from operations stood at ₹70,108 crore compared with ₹64,472 crore in the year ago period, it added.

## Govt. says 2,645 posts vacant at AAL 3 aviation regulators

A total of 2,645 positions are lying vacant at the Airports Authority of India (AAI) and three aviation regulators ICAO, ICAO and AERA, the government said on Thursday. In a written reply to Lok Sabha, Union Civil Aviation Minister Mohiuddin Ali Khan said that the government is taking steps to fill up vacancies under the ministry, including its attached offices and regulatory bodies. At the Directorate General of Civil Aviation, there are 787 vacancies, largely due to the creation of 441 additional posts as part of the restructuring undertaken during 2022-2024.

## TRAI issues telecom services interconnection regulations

The Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI) on Thursday issued the Telecommunication (Broadbanding and Cable) Services Interconnection (Addressable Systems) (Seventh Amendment) Regulations, 2026. The salient features include clearly defined timelines for audits, wherein distributors have to conduct audit and submit audit report to broadbanders by September 30 every year; audit to be done on business day basis on a calendar year basis; from the date of broadcast; representatives during audit to ensure transparency and credibility.

## LIC Q3 net climbs 17% to ₹12,958 crore on premium

State-owned Life Insurance Corporation of India (LIC) reported standalone net profit for the December quarter increased more than 17% year-on-year to ₹12,958.22 crore.

The higher net profit came on 17.9% increase in the net premium income to ₹1,25,613.36 crore (₹1,06,891.48 crore). Total income increased almost 16% to ₹2,33,563.79 crore.

The discussions on the FTA with GCC have been going on for two decades and now finally reached the ToR stage, ready to take-off more than two decades after the first attempt was made.

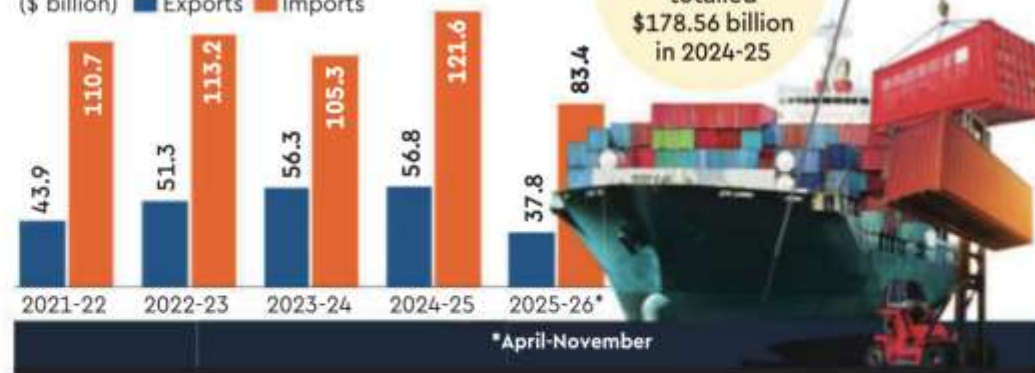
The ToR establishes the framework, scope, objectives, and procedures for the negotiations. The signing of ToR is the first step for negotiations to begin.

"It is most appropriate that we now enter into a much stronger and robust trading arrangement which will enable greater free flow of goods and services, bring predictability and stability to policy, help encourage greater degree of investments and take our bilateral relations between the six nation GCC group and India to greater heights," Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal said at the signing of the ToR.

because when it comes to just goods trade the GCC — that includes Saudi Arabia, United Arab Emirates, Oman, Qatar, Bahrain and Kuwait — is India's biggest partner.

The bilateral trade between two sides totalled \$178.56 billion in 2024-25 with India's exports at \$58.87 billion and imports at \$121.68 billion.

In August 2004, India and GCC signed a Framework Agreement on Economic Cooperation, paving the way for FTA talks. In 2006 and 2008, two rounds of negotiations were held. In 2009, the GCC deferred its negotiations with all countries.

The UAE is India's biggest trade partner in the GCC with bilateral trade of \$100 billion followed by Saudi Arabia at \$41.8 billion. It is an important source of Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) with inflows totalling \$31 billion between April 2000 and September 2025.

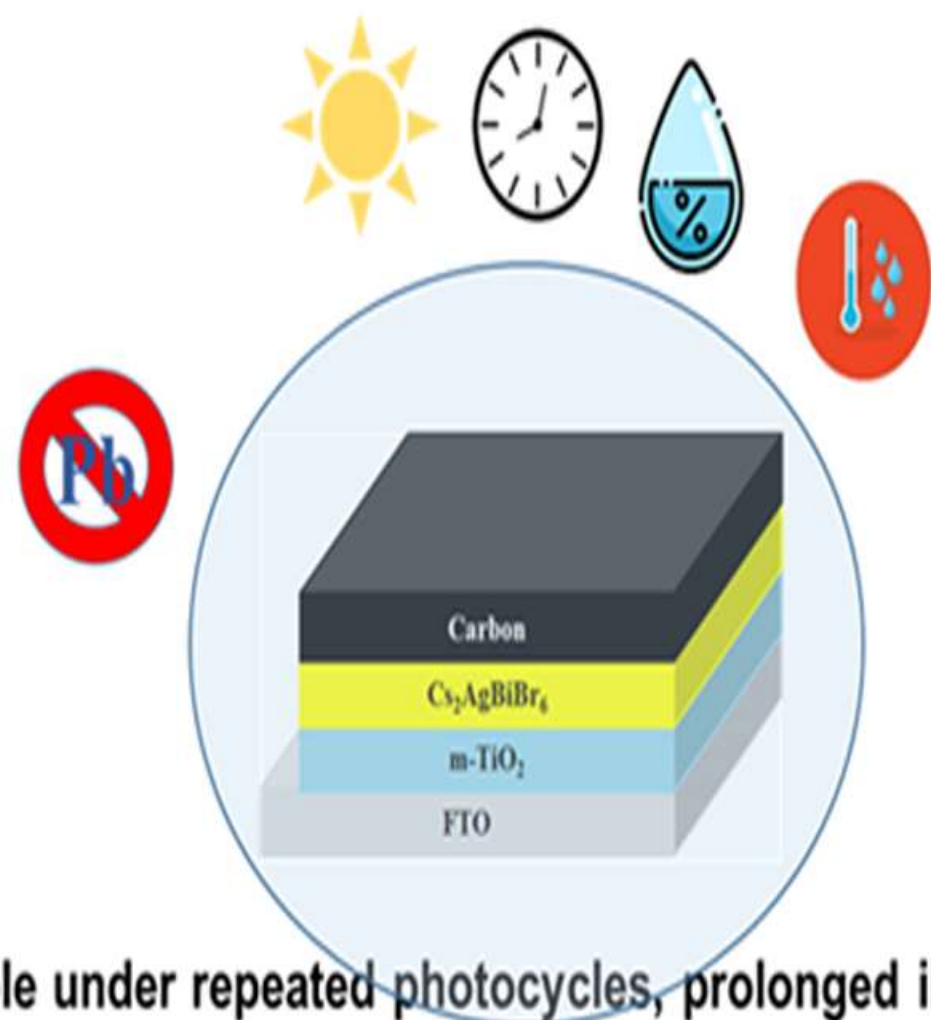

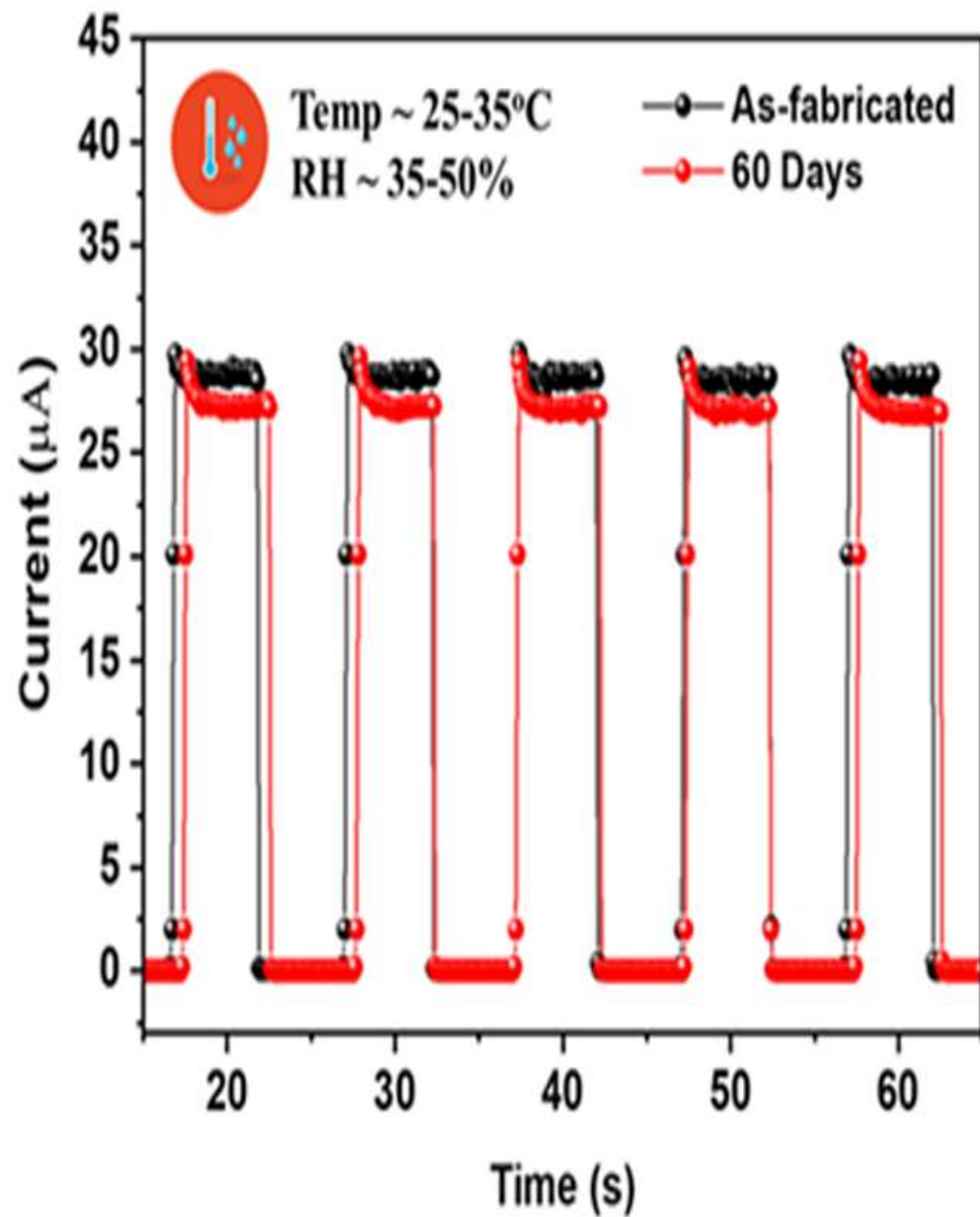
